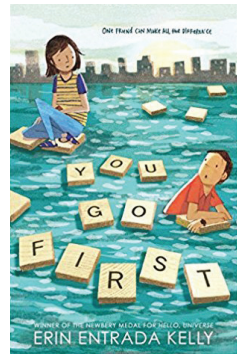
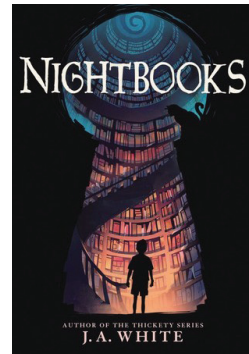
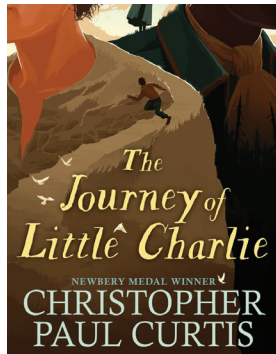
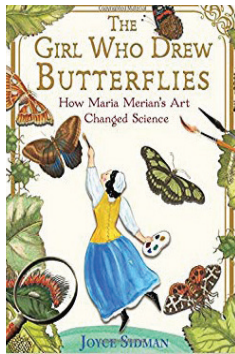
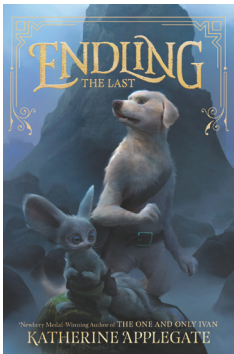


# Heavy Medal Mock Newbery Awards
