Compose a Summer of Color Instructions for Weaving with CDs

Materials:

1 CD, yarn, scissors and a blunt needle

Creating the Warp:

- 1. Cut a length of yarn for the warp, 2 arm lengths or about 4 feet long. Pull one end through the center of the CD and knot it to itself on the back or label side of the CD.
- 2. Flip the CD over to the front or shiny side; begin wrapping the yarn around the CD to make spokes as on a bike wheel. Make sure to pull it tight as you go. End with an <u>uneven</u> number of spokes. (7 for easy, 13 or more for a challenge.)
- 3. When you have enough spokes, tie off the end of the yarn on the back of the CD.

Weaving:

- 1. Cut a length of yarn and tie it to a spoke on the back side of the CD. Thread your needle with the loose end of your yarn and pull it to the right side.
- 2. Weave the needle with the yarn under and over several spokes, pulling the yarn down and tight as you go.
- 3. To add a new color, push your needle under the woven section and pull out the other side. Clip to hide your end. Thread your needle with a new color and slide the needle under the woven section to hide the end.

Finishing:

- 1. After you have woven to your desired width, tie the end of the yarn to one of the spokes, then tuck it in. Clip the end.
- 2. Decorate any of the CD that is still showing with sharpies.
- 3. Bring your finished creations to the Children's Desk at the Library and we will display them on the clay brick wall!
